

YOUNG MARINE GENERAL ORDERS

- YMGO# 1.** While on firewatch I will remain awake and alert until relieved by my replacement or authorized adult.
- YMGO# 2.** I will enforce all orders given me by the adult in charge.
- YMGO# 3.** I will report all dangerous activity immediately to the adult in charge.
- YMGO# 4.** I will never forget that I am a Young Marine and will perform my duties to the best of my ability.

FIREWATCH / INTERIOR GUARD

THE CORPORAL OF THE GUARD: The corporal of the guard supervises and posts and relieves the sentries.

SENTINELS / FIREWATCH: The sentry is the workhorse of the guard. A sentry carries out the general orders as well as any special orders. Sentinels walk their post and do not leave until properly relieved by the CPL of the Guard. Firewatch is a specific sentry post that is assigned the duty of maintaining order after lights out. While on firewatch, you are on the lookout for anything that could bring harm to your fellow Young Marines. Remain alert and carry out your duties to the best of your ability.

SUPERNUMERARY: The supernumerary is a standby relief in case any guard must be relieved. The supernumerary is often used as a messenger.

DUTIES OF A TEAM MEMBER

1. Comply with rules and orders / FOLLOW ORDERS;
2. Make responsible decisions for your own (and your teammates') safety;
3. Maintain good personal habits and manners;
4. Admit your mistakes and learn from experience;
5. Cooperate with others and work as a member of a team;
6. Accept constructive criticism;
7. Take care of all personal and group equipment—repair or report items of equipment and clothing when they break or become damaged; and,
8. Encourage your teammates.

As a Young Marine, you will develop a sense of teamwork, trust and friendship. Simply put, "TEAM" means:

- **T** — Together
- **E** — Everyone
- **A** — Accomplishes
- **M** — More

Making responsible decisions means doing the right thing even when no one is watching.
