

CAMOUFLAGE BLOUSE.

“Young Marine” nametape: Centered above the LEFT breast pocket, flush to the pocket seam and flush to the edge of the pocket (see Figure 1).

Nametape: An olive drab nametape is worn centered over the RIGHT pocket, flush to the pocket seam and flush to the edges of the pocket (see Figure 1).

Note: The ends of the name tapes should be folded in approximately 1/2” (but overall length of nametape must be flush with the edges of the pocket) so that it does not leave an unfinished edge to the name tapes (see Figure 2) (but overall length of nametape must be flush with the edges of the pocket).

Young Marine shoulder patch: Worn on the wearer's LEFT sleeve with the unit designation arc centered above the patch, on the shoulder seam, (see Figure 3).

CAMOUFLAGE TROUSERS.

Nametape: Sewn over the RIGHT rear pocket of the trousers, centered and flush over the top seam, (see figure 4).

Note: The ends of the name tapes should be folded in approximately 1/2" (but overall length of nametape must be flush with the edges of the pocket) so that it does not leave an unfinished edge to the name tapes (see Figure 2) (but overall length of nametape must be flush with the edges of the pocket).
